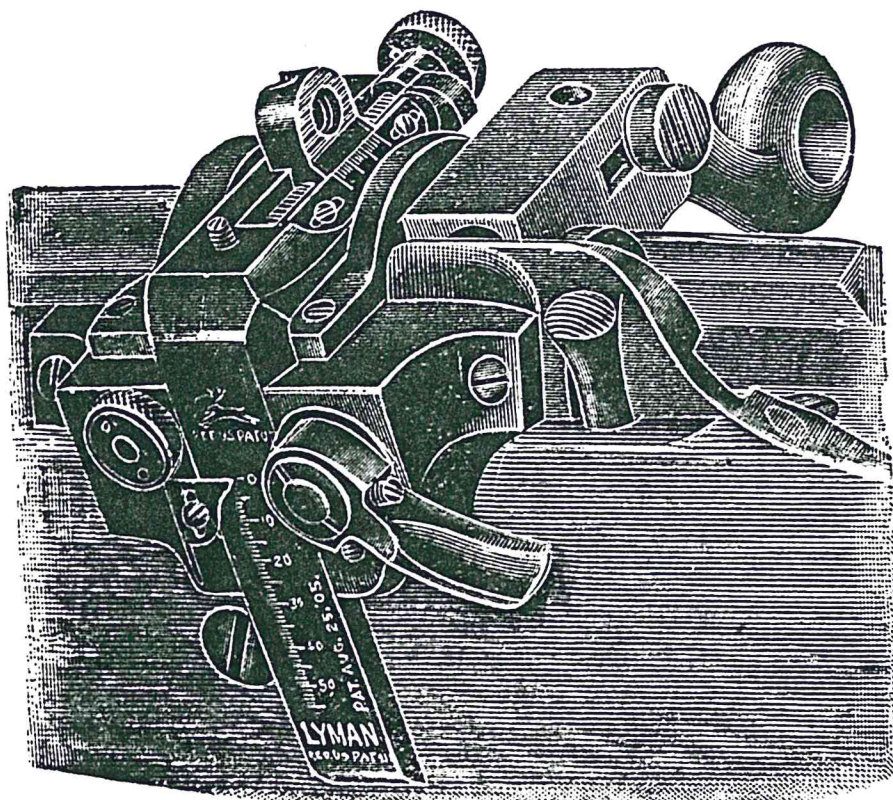


LYMAN WINDGAUGE RECEIVER SIGHT

Sight should be set as shown in cut, thereby giving clearance to both the forward and backward action of the bolt.

When used on a .280 a special height of front sight is required to permit the longer back movement of the bolt with this long cartridge. Stock must be recessed to accommodate the base.

Drill frame with a No. 37 drill; tap $\frac{1}{8}$ -48. Mounting screws should not be filed to permit re-entrance of the bolt until they are firmly and permanently set.
